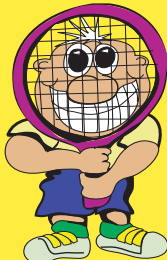

**SKI SEASON IS HERE!!** Our first trip is December 7th to Utah. There may be last minute spots available—check with Gary George, Trip Leader, for availability.

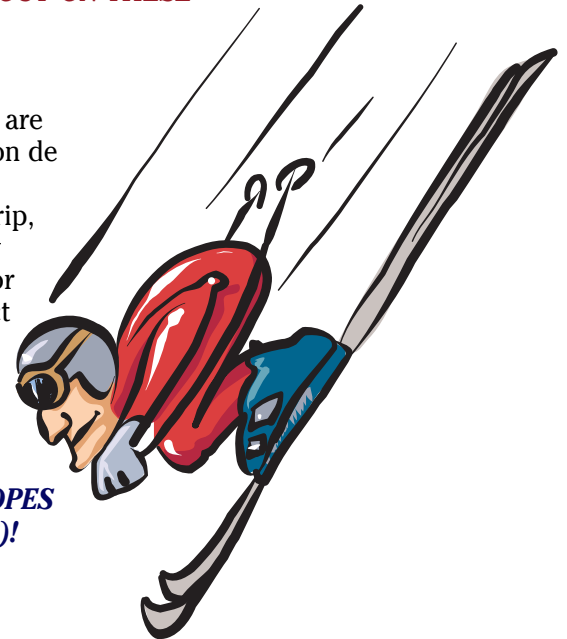
