Director's Column

Greetings Las Vegas Ski and Sports Club Members

This year, the members of Board of Directors of the club are reviewing and updating our governing documents. In some cases we are attempting to address new or changing issues and in other cases we are attempting to reconcile contradictions, correct errors and resolve ambiguities. When we have completed this process, the revised documents will be presented to the membership for your approval.

At our first Board of Directors meeting, we approved the creation of two new positions: A fundraising position, chaired by Phyllis Silvaggio, assisted by Jeff Chow and Diane Askwyth, and a legal matters position, chaired by Michael Phillips. We are still formulating the scope, duties and responsibilities for these positions.

On the matter of fundraising, the Board felt that we should make an effort now to supplement our club revenue to offset the reduction in income which has resulted from declining membership. Michael Henderson, the club treasurer, has made a valiant and successful effort to control costs and prioritize expenses and we are solvent with a small surplus. We discussed various fundraising ideas at the last meeting and we will explore the feasibility and try to implement some of them in the near future. It may be an iterative process; where we try, evaluate and if unsuccessful, try something else.

In a related economic matter trip planning was discussed at length. We have resurrected a more rigorous, spread-sheet based, trip calculation form. This calculation form will enable trip leaders to better estimate the true cost of trips and will reduce excessive trip losses or surpluses and perhaps even allow for inclusion of optional trip activities or incentives. We have decided to eliminate refunds of surpluses for future trips and events. Any and all exceptions will be at the discretion of the Board of Directors.

As always, your participation and input are welcome at meetings, socials and other activities.

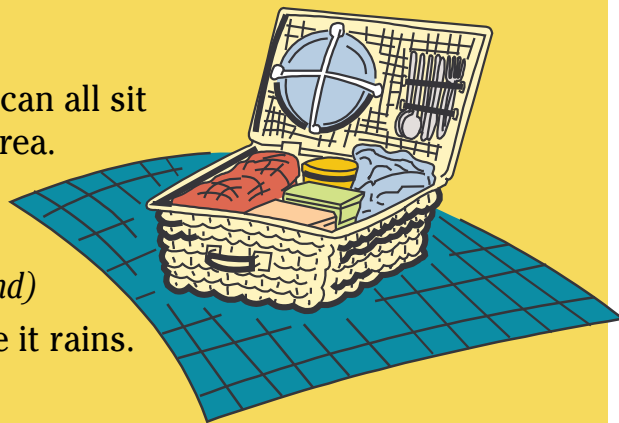

Cool Weekend in Pioche

Our summer heat is just beginning and after some cold winter days it is a pleasant change. Now fast-forward to July when the Las Vegas temperature is reaching the 110° mark and Pioche, Nevada is 20° degrees cooler. Well, we are in the early planning stages of a **weekend in Pioche – July 8 – 10, 2011.**

Pioche began with a silver discovery in the winter of 1863. It has a rich history in silver and other mineral mining. Like many of the Old West boomtowns, Pioche was notorious for its lawlessness. Some historians have noted that the only difference between more famous old western towns such as Deadwood, Tombstone and Dodge City was – they had a public relations department and Pioche didn't! It is the county seat for Lincoln County, which at one time included Las Vegas. More important it offers many outdoor activities such as hiking in nearby Cathedral Gorge and up Lime Hill, as well as a "unique" golfing experience.

Tentative plans are being made and we do not have all of the details to determine the cost of the trip. We are planning to get rooms at the Overland Hotel, as well as hook-ups for those folks who want to bring their recreational vehicles. The weekend would include a mini-TGIF at the Overland Hotel on Friday evening. On Saturday there would be several activities and a group dinner. On Sunday we would have a continental breakfast prior to the return trip to the heat in Las Vegas.
